Ted Legasey is a Distinguished Graduate of the U.S. Air Force Academy. He has a BS in Mathematics and was commissioned as a 2Lt in the US Air Force. He retired from SRA as Executive Vice President and Chief Operating Officer in 2004. Ted has broad and deep experience with various industry associations, business roundtables, and boards.
